Tactical Leadership is designed to provide the front-line leader and all other officers with the tools necessary to effectively prepare for, evaluate, manage, and lead during critical incidents from start to finish. This one-day course establishes that a cohesive and forward-thinking team needs on-scene leadership to effectively handle events.

Videos of traffic stops and actual critical incidents will be viewed, analyzed, and discussed among attendees to develop a workable understanding of how to manage the event to a successful, peaceful resolution. This class also includes self-lead suggestions which promote good decisions based on training and experience. Tactical Leadership will also provide the tools to:

- Apply leadership skills to address common officer issues
- Open forum discussions: pre-mortem strategies
- Prepare both the leader and the team for all levels of incidents, especially critical
- Recognize, evaluate, and correct errors during and after the incident
- Create a culture of investment and ownership in your team
- Communicate effectively with your team during a critical incident
- Apply best practices for de-escalation, crowd management, and other high-value contacts
- Foster succession by developing leadership and critical thinking skills in **all** staff
- Act and decide effectively during critical incidents
