

Full-Time Program Enrollment Checklist **4 Steps!**

1 Attend an information session, tour the campus and fill out an application.

- Visit adults.greatoaks.com/career-admissions/information-sessions or call 513.771.8881.

2 Start your financial aid. (See **financial aid** on the back.)

- If you are planning to use **Federal Student Grants and Loans**, refer to the **yellow box** on the back.
- If you are planning to **Self-Pay**, refer to the **blue box** on the back.
- If you are planning to use **VA Educational Benefits**, refer to the **green box** on the back.

3 Successfully complete the entrance assessment. (WorkKeys®)

On WorkKeys® you must achieve at least a **Level 4** on each of the three parts: **Applied Math, Graphic Literacy** and **Workplace Documents**. (Police and Fire Academies require a **Level 5** on Workplace Documents.)

Call 513.771.8881 to schedule the WorkKeys. (Entrance assessment)

- First scheduled test is FREE with application. Time restrictions do apply.

Take the Entrance assessment and achieve benchmarks.

- On test day, bring a valid government issued ID and your high school diploma. Arrive 15 minutes early & plan on 3.5 hours for testing. The test is computer based and results will be printed for you immediately.
- **Foreign diplomas** must be translated and evaluated by a credential evaluator. See requirements on Great Oaks website. (Under the Admissions Tab, select "Full-Time Program Admissions" and then "Financial Aid." Once on Financial Aid page, select **Foreign Diploma Requirements** under "More Information."

4 Finish financial aid and return all required documents!

Financial Aid Choose an Option

Option 1: Planning to use Federal Student Grants and Loans to pay for your schooling at Great Oaks?

Follow these easy steps:

- Create a FSA ID and Password** (*parents of dependent students must do this step too!) Go to fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm. Please be sure to write down your (and your parents) FSA ID, as it will be needed for future steps!
- Complete the 2019-2020 FAFSA® (it's FREE!)** Go to fafsa.ed.gov/. Our federal school code is 014694. Please be sure to use your 2017 tax information and the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.
- Resolve Issues (if any)** Wait at least 1 week after submitting your FAFSA for the Financial Aid Office to contact you about your next steps.
- Review and Complete Award Letter and ALL Online Processes** Carefully read, sign, date and return all 4 pages of Award Letter to the Financial Aid Office. Then go to studentloans.gov/myDirectLoan/index.action# to complete all mandatory online processes from page 2 of the Award Letter (your parent(s) may need to complete online processes as well).
- Pay Balance Owed (if any)** Follow the directions on the invoice sent to you by the Bursar after you have taken and passed all 3 WorkKeys® tests.

*Dependent Student = under the age of 24, not married, doesn't have dependents, not serving on active duty, not a veteran, not an orphan, not homeless or emancipated.

Option 2: Planning to use Self-Pay to pay for your schooling at Great Oaks?

Option 3: Planning to use VA® Educational Benefits to pay for your schooling at Great Oaks?

Follow these easy steps:

- Apply for Benefits (if never applied for benefits) or Complete Change of Training (if applied for benefits in the past)** To apply for benefits, go to <https://www.vets.gov/education/apply-for-education-benefits/application/1990/introduction>. To complete a change of training, go to www.vets.gov/education/apply-for-education-benefits/application/1995/introduction.
- Complete Federal Student Grants/Loans Steps (in the above yellow box if needed)** VA educational benefits **do not** cover all costs of our programs and each program varies on costs not covered. If you have further questions about this, please contact the Financial Aid Office.
- Provide your Certificate of Eligibility (COE) to the Financial Aid Office** Fax or email your COE to the Financial Aid Office. If you don't have your COE, print your entitlement page from ebenefits.va.gov/ebenefits/homepage and fax or email it to the Financial Aid Office.
- Schedule an Appointment with the VA School Certifying Official (Cindy Albright)** This appointment is to finalize all necessary VA and financial aid documentation and is mandatory.
