

# Do you qualify for funding? (Hamilton County only)

## Choose *one* of these options if:

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### ***You receive SNAP (food stamp assistance) but not cash assistance***

May fund 5 WK PLUS STNA/PCA, STNA, or PCA, WorkKeys and background checks  
Request an HPA/SNAP Release/Verification Form & return to HPA for verification  
Must submit all medical paperwork and diploma before SNAP will fund WorkKeys or background

### ***You are age 16 TO 24***

***Your household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) (see back of page)***

**Choose just one: Equus or Santa Maria—very similar programs**

1. **Santa Maria** - case management expectations / a minor child in the home may be a requirement

May fund STNA, PCA, PLUS, CCMA, Pharm Tech, transportation, scrubs & pre-requisites

Contact (513) 557-7254 immediately & attend Santa Maria orientation

2. **Equus (My Life through ResCare)** - case management / a minor child in the home may be a requirement

May fund STNA, PCA, 5 WK PLUS, CCMA, Pharm Tech, transportation, scrubs & pre-requisites

### ***Your household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) (see back of page)***

You have a minor child in the home

1. **STEPS**—Hamilton County— case management expectations

May fund any class, transportation, pre-requisites and scrubs

If you have a child in Head Start, contact Sherry Childers at Community Action: 513.924.2012

2. **PRC - Hamilton County**

May fund only STNA, PCA, or 5 WK PLUS STNA/PCA classes, but also transportation and scrubs assistance

Request an application from HPA after WorkKeys assessment is completed successfully

### ***Your household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) (see back of page)***

**Hamilton County Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA) (see back for other counties)**

May fund any class, but not pre-requisites

Complete HPA pre-requisites (WorkKeys, etc.) & request an application from HPA

Work with a WIOA representative and provide income verification & WorkKeys scores

***The funding enrollment and eligibility determination process may take several weeks and you may encounter wait lists or changes in funding availability or requirements.***
