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Financial Information

- You will need to provide your tax information from 2019
- If you are a dependent student your parent(s) will need to provide their tax information from 2019
- If you and/or your parent(s) filed a federal tax return in 2019, you may be able to use the IRS DATA Retrieval Tool. This tool enables you to easily, accurately and securely transfer your tax information into the online FAFSA form.

Sign & Submit

- You must electronically sign your FAFSA
- Parent(s) must electronically sign your FAFSA (if you are a dependent student)
- **SAVE AND SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA**

Confirmation

- You will receive an email confirmation that your FAFSA was sent to Great Oaks.
- Great Oaks will receive your FAFSA within 4 to 5 days; **however, this does not complete the FAFSA process.**
- Once Great Oaks receives your FAFSA, a financial aid associate from Great Oaks will review your FAFSA and will contact you about the next steps in completing your FAFSA.
